INSTRUCTIONS 2024 SUBSTANCE FREE GRAD NIGHT PARTY

WEDNESDAY, MAY 7TH, 10:45AM

Seniors will pick up their cap & gowns in the gym at WLHS. They will also be given a clear, labeled bag, which will be used for a change of clothes and shoes, medications, swimsuit, hygiene products, etc., to take to the Grad Party. Detailed instructions will be included in this bag, on procedures for what to do with the bag. PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. You will want it at the grad party!

TUESDAY, JUNE 4TH, 8:45AM

Seniors will gather at WLHS and receive instructions from WLHS staff prior to leaving for rehearsal. Seniors will depart on the buses for rehearsal at approximately 9:30am and return some time after lunch.

For Seniors who registered to attend the Grad Party, you will also check-in to get a wristband which is proof of Grad Party registration, with your name and bus # assignment. **THIS WRISTBAND IS TO REMAIN ON YOU ALL DAY, THROUGH GRADUATION, UNTIL AFTER THE GRAD PARTY.**

TUESDAY, JUNE 4TH, 6:00pm

Seniors must be at Veteran's Memorial Coliseum. Graduation ceremonies begin at 7:00pm.

AFTER GRADUATION at approximately 9:45-10:00

Seniors, please leave the following with your family:

- *Extra clothes (cap & gown, suit jackets, dress shoes) – you will be able to change at the grad party venue.*
- **NO CELLPHONES** and any other electronics (these are not allowed into the grad party venue); A photobooth will be available at the event that will share the pictures.
- *Any form of substances (strictly prohibited)*

Once you have NOTHING in your hands or pockets, proceed to your assigned bus (shown on your wristband). All non-authorized items will be confiscated so leave them with your family.

Check in with the Grad Party Bus Volunteer Chaperone on your assigned bus. They have a list of who is on their bus. BUSES LEAVE AT 10:00 SHARP, so please DO NOT BE LATE!

*** **NO EXCEPTIONS** or **CHANGES TO BUS ASSIGNMENTS*****

ARRIVAL AT GRAD PARTY

Your Volunteer Bus Chaperone will read rules, instructions, and grad party information. Remain on the bus until your Chaperone releases you. Bring your personal bags into the grad party venue to change if needed and then check in the bags at bag check.

DEPARTURE FROM GRAD PARTY, JUNE 5TH, APPROXIMATELY 4:30AM

Any personal plastic bags with stored clothing and/or medication, along with any prizes, should be picked up prior to leaving. Some winnings and prizes may be handed out on the bus or upon arrival to WLHS. YOU MUST BOARD THE SAME ASSIGNED BUS # TO RETURN TO WLHS.

Cars may not be left at WLHS overnight and will be towed! Since Seniors will not have their cell phones, families should park in their Senior's school parking spot and meet them there.

BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT

Please read and sign this form. Only students who have completed all 4 forms are allowed to attend the party

The 2024 WLHS Substance-Free Grad Party is organized and chaperoned by parent volunteers. It is NOT a WLHS sponsored function. To ensure the success of this annual event, the following behaviors will need to be followed.

1. This is a substance-free event. This means NO alcoholic beverages, tobacco, drugs or non-prescribed substances will be tolerated.
2. This event is ONLY open to WLHS Seniors.
3. To ensure the success of this event and our student's safety, the location of this event is TOP SECRET.
4. Seniors are REQUIRED to ride buses to and from the event. Buses will depart from Veterans Memorial Coliseum after the graduation commencement ceremonies at approximately 10:00-10:30 pm on Tuesday June 4, 2024. Students will return to WLHS at approximately 5:00 am on Wednesday June 5, 2024.
5. Seniors will be REQUIRED to remain at the party's venue throughout the ENTIRE event.
6. Any inappropriate, disrespectful behavior, profanity, indecent exposure, violence, threats of violence, damage to property, injury to self or others, or use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs and non-prescription substances, will NOT be tolerated. If this does occur, parents will be contacted, regardless of the time, and will need to pick up their graduate.
7. NOT ALLOWED: **Cell phones**, cameras, electronics of any kind, purses, backpacks, valuables. towels, hair dryers, hair products, cap and gown. There will NOT be a secure area to store anything of value. All items not allowed will be confiscated immediately, so empty all pockets. There will be a photo booth available where graduates can get pictures during the party as well as a volunteer taking photos throughout the party. Photos will be available to families after the party.
8. Wristbands are proof of Grad Party registration and will be attached on students' wrists the morning of Graduation, before attending Graduation rehearsal. It is imperative that they wear this band all day. ONLY students with wristbands will be allowed to board the buses for the party and enter the Grad Party venue.
9. All chaperones will have cell phones. If students need to contact parents during the event, it can be done.
10. For safety reasons, cars are not allowed to be left at the high school overnight. Parents will be expected to pick students up at the high school @ approximately 5:00 am on Wednesday June 5th, 2024.

**GRAD NIGHT PARTICIPANT RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY,
ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

The undersigned hereby certifies that I am the legal parent/guardian of _____, a graduate (hereinafter the "PARTICIPANT") participating in GRAD NIGHT activities at an undisclosed location (hereinafter the "HOSTING FACILITY"). In consideration of being permitted to enter the HOSTING FACILITY'S premises and being granted access to the HOSTING FACILITY'S amenities and services, and being permitted to participate in any of the GRAD NIGHT activities at the HOSTING FACILITY, the undersigned:

1. Agrees that he/she will instruct the PARTICIPANT that he or she must adhere to the HOSTING FACILITY'S Rules of Conduct and may not be under the influence of, or use, illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol prior to or during the event.
2. Agrees that any damages caused by the PARTICIPANT will be paid by the undersigned to the owner(s) of the damaged item(s).
3. Represents that the participant has medical coverage and has been released to participate in the activities conducted during GRAD NIGHT by his/her personnel physician and understands that in the event of a medical emergency, the undersigned or the listed emergency contact person will be notified immediately, and if neither are available for consultation, grants permission to the HOSTING FACILITY to obtain medical treatment as deemed necessary.
4. Hereby releases, waives and discharges the HOSTING FACILITY, including its officers, agents, employees, managers, independent contractors, parent organizations, subsidiaries, affiliates and personnel ("Releasees") from, and agrees and covenants not to sue Releasees for, any claim, liability, or demand of any kind or on account of any personal injury, temporary or permanent disability, death, property damage, or other damages to PARTICIPANT or the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of Releasees or otherwise, resulting from or in any way associated with the PARTICIPANT or undersigned's entry on the HOSTING FACILITY'S premises or use of the HOSTING FACILITY'S amenities and services, or participation in any of the GRAD NIGHT activities at the HOSTING FACILITY. Further, the undersigned agrees and covenants to indemnify Releasees for, and hold Releasees harmless, from any such claims, liabilities or demands.
5. HEREBY VOLUNTARILY ASSUMES ALL RISKS of personal injury, including temporary or permanent disability or death, property damage, economic losses, and/or other damages to PARTICIPANT and/or undersigned resulting from or in any way associated with the PARTICIPANT or undersigned's entry on the HOSTING FACILITY'S premises or use of the HOSTING FACILITY'S amenities and services, or participation in any of the GRAD NIGHT activities at the HOSTING FACILITY.
6. Acknowledges and agrees that this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT is intended to be, and is, a complete release of any responsibility of Releasees for personal injuries and/or temporary or permanent disability or death and/or property loss/damage sustained by the PARTICIPANT or undersigned while on the HOSTING FACILITY'S premises or while using the HOSTING FACILITY'S amenities and services, or while participating in any of the GRAD NIGHT activities at the HOSTING FACILITY; and undersigned further acknowledges and agrees that it is specifically intended to and does include release, waiver, assumption of risk and indemnity as to premises liability claims such as (by example, not limitation) slip & falls and/or trip & falls at the HOSTING FACILITY.
7. Understands that this waiver and release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of this state and that if any portion of this waiver and release is held invalid, the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect.
